

AZEMITOLOGS 2023 – OCTOBER 2 IN THE COURTYARD OF JELGAVA PALACE

The celebration of the Azemitologs confirms belonging, love and devotion to place, people and traditions – created, shaped and nurtured together. In the distant autumn of 1968, then-university first year students were first addressed by his excellency, the patron of our university, an Azemitologs. Since then, every year as the symbol of all specialities of the Latvia University of Life Sciences and Technologies and knowledge, Azemitologs welcomes students of the 1st year of our university, including all in the large family of students. It's a celebration of studying, unity, wisdom, wit and fun. The Azemitolog's festival is a celebration of our Alma Mater affiliation, patriotism, friendship, pride and joy.

For Azemitologs 2023 all faculties and their first year students are invited to prepare a theatrical home assignment - a performance (up to 5-6 minutes long) with a theme:

“EVERY BIG DREAM STARTS WITH A DREAMER...” BY TONY ROBIN

The Azemitologs invites the performance to be developed responsibly, meaningfully, wittily, attractively and positively, choosing and emphasising current events – in Latvia, Europe and the World. Be creative, attractive and studious! Azemitologs stresses it's not mandatory to include mentioning all LBTU faculties in performance.

On October 2 faculties enter the palace yard (five people in a column):

- 14.52 Faculty of Engineering and Information Technologies
- 14.54 Faculty of Agriculture and Food Technology
- 14.56 Faculty of Forest and Environmental Sciences
- 14.58 Faculty of Economics and Social Development
- 15.00 Faculty of Veterinary Medicine
- 15.05 The beginning of Azemitologs.

At the invitation of the Azemitologs, performances prepared by students of all faculties will be presented. Faculty speaking order during Azemitologs festivities: ESAF, VMF, LPTF, MVZF, IITF

The evaluation and criteria for the performances of participants of the festivities will be evaluated by the jury commission, which includes deans of all faculties, university guests from Jelgava Municipality, representatives of student public organisations. The following criteria will be taken into account:

- bidding under given conditions;
- manner and mood of arrival;
- a representation of the selected study direction in the design of the column;
- visibility and ingenuity of the homework performance;
- clarity and comprehensibility of the performance idea, coverage in the Mise en Scene;
- student cohesion, unity, patriotism, the spur of self-confidence and competitiveness during the festive period.

At the discretion of the jury, penalty points may also be awarded for delay, irresponsibility and lightness in given circumstances, delay of performance, exceeding of execution time (5-6 minutes), indiscipline and showing disrespect during other faculty appearances.

Awarding. In the overall ranking, the Azemitologs will present the big and small traveling award to the best faculty. For selected faculty. The travelling awards will also be presented by student corporations and the LBTU student authority. Other surprises and special awards may also be possible.
